Church-planting and Outreach. We hosted two teams from the USA in January, February, and March before the government in Ivory Coast imposed a curfew, closed all non-essential travel within the country, and closed all schools and churches. A building and medical team from Southern Missouri, hosted by Pastor Veazey from 2nd Assembly of God, Joplin, built **three tabernacles** in Daloa & Soubre, Ivory Coast in January.

The Joplin team also facilitated a **medical outreach**. Three doctors and three nurses from America joined 3 doctors and 3 nurses from the Ivory Coast to treat **over 1000 people** in 5 days. We preached, prayed with all participants, and demonstrated the love of God daily. **Over 40 people accepted Jesus Christ** for the first time and have been added to local churches because of this outreach. We held the clinic in a church and home built by churches in Missouri in an ongoing project to provide shelter for women and children who are newly converted to Christianity. **A special thank you to Pastor Jerry Orf and 1st AG, Mansfield, MO and Sherry Welch and the SOMO Women's Ministry for these great facilities!**

One tabernacle will serve as a local church in a village near the capital, Abidjan, and the other two will serve as classrooms for our new Bible institute in Abengourou.
